- * Plant year round
- * Care for plot weekly
- * Keep plot and surrounding area weed-free
- * Contribute 2 hours/month as your schedule permits in community maintenance tasks
- * Harvest 2-3 times every three months (1-2 hours on Saturday morning)
- * Attend a monthly Saturday lunch social several times a year
- * Care for tools
- * Annual fee of \$40
